

# House Bill No. 35

HOUSE BILL NO. 35—By GRAHAM and WINDLE

## COMMITTEE REPORT

Mr. Speaker:

We, your committee on Appropriations to whom was referred House Bill No. 35 beg leave to report that we have had the same under consideration, and herewith return the same with the recommendation that it do pass.

With the following amendments:

Substitute the following for House Bill No. 35:

AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE STATE BOARD OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS TO BUILD AND FURNISH A MANSION FOR THE GOVERNOR OF OKLAHOMA AND TO LANDSCAPE THE GROUNDS THEREOF; MAKING APPROPRIATION THEREFOR AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. The Board of Public Affairs are  
2 hereby authorized and directed to build or cause to  
3 be built, a mansion for the Governor of Oklahoma,  
4 on lands owned by the State and adjacent to the State  
5 Capitol Building, on the East side of the said build-  
6 ing, which site was heretofore designated by the so-  
7 called Kessler landscape plans, for the building of  
8 such a mansion, at a total cost of not to exceed  
9 Seventy-five Thousand (\$75,000.00) Dollars, and to  
10 furnish the same at a total cost of not to exceed  
11 Twenty-five Thousand (\$25,000.00) Dollars, and for  
12 landscaping, grading, paving, and other improvements  
13 of the grounds surrounding the same at a cost not to  
14 exceed Fifteen Thousand (\$15,000.00) Dollars.

15 SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated out  
16 of any funds in the State Treasury, not otherwise  
17 appropriated, the sum of Seventy-five Thousand (\$75,-  
18 000.000) Dollars for the building of said mansion,

1 Twenty-five Thousand (\$25,000.00) Dollars for fur-  
2 nishing said mansion, and Fifteen Thousand (\$15,-  
3 000.00) Dollars for landscaping, grading, paving, and  
4 other improvements of the grounds surrounding said  
5 mansion, or so much of said appropriation as may be  
6 found necessary.

7 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for  
8 the preservation of the public peace, health and safety,  
9 an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason  
10 whereof this Act shall be in full force from and after  
11 its passage and approval.
